



## Reppert – Graybeal Volunteer Award

*"When you do what you do 'cause you love what you love ..."*

*The nominee may be a volunteering:*

- *Driver, safety professional, trainer, operation person, manager, supervisor, etc. who has volunteered and worked in any capacity for PA TDC and other TDCs.*

### Eligibility

- The nominee volunteer must have been involved in the PA TDCs in any capacity for a minimum of ten years and volunteered for at least five years.
- The nominee volunteer may have done a mix of volunteer work in any position.
- The nominee volunteer can be a former driver (who now is volunteering), a safety professional, manager, supervisor, owner, etc., who have worked on the TDCs.
- The nominee volunteer can be nominated in subsequent years by filing a new entry provided they continue to be eligible, however, any recipient of the Reppert - Graybeal Volunteer Award cannot be nominated in any following year.

### Nomination

- Nominations must be submitted on the form provided by the Safety Management Council (SMC).
- Nominations may be made by any party.
- Nominations must be received by May 1<sup>st</sup>, at PMTA/SMC at 910 Linda Lane, Camp Hill, PA
- In addition to the official entry form you may also want to submit a letter stating the basis for the nomination outlining the nominee's accomplishments, letters or note from member of his/her family, and any other information in support of the nomination.

### Judging

- Each year those who have been nominated shall be reviewed.
  - Indicate in what areas
  - What years
  - Note whether they volunteer on their own dime.
    - This is NOT necessarily the deciding factor.
- Look for commitment, passion and contribution to the Championships program at all levels: State, regional (if applicable) and national.
- A committee made up of:
  - The PMTA Safety Director or their designate, and two PMTA/SMC Board Members.
  - The selection shall remain a secret and be presented just before the drivers awards are presented.
- The award shall be etched with a photo of Jake Reppert and Rich Graybeal, and inscribed with Dan Baker's poem – The Visible Proof.
